## Core

- Offload shipment from the inbound vehicle at the clearance point.
- Sort shipment by pieces and Airway bill number.
- Open cartons in front of customs officials.
- Loading all cleared shipments into SMSA vehicles
- Transport the confiscated shipments to the allocated storage place.
- Ensure accurate scanning and segregation for shipments by SMSA core system and sending the report to clearance specialist.
- Inform assistant clearance agent if any shipment is damage upon receipt from airlines or ground handling agent.
- Prepare align and wrapping.
- Other task/job and other responsibilities requested by manager on a time-to-time basis.
