

## **HANDLING INSTRUCTIONS FOR GASOLINE SAMPLE SHIPMENTS**

- Keep container upright in vehicle
- Do not load next to or close to foodstuff. Do not store with other dangerous goods in vehicle.
- Secure container in vehicle from moving around
- Keep away from heat/sparks/open flames/hot surfaces
- No smoking
- Use gloves when handling container

### **PPE**

- Wear protective gloves/protective clothing/eye protection/face protection.
- Wash hands and forearms thoroughly after handling.
- Do not breathe mist/vapours/spray.
- Do not eat, drink or smoke when handling this product.

### **SPILL OR LEAK**

- ELIMINATE all ignition sources (no smoking, flares, sparks or flames) from immediate area.
- All equipment used when handling the product must be grounded.
- Do not touch or walk through spilled material.
- Stop leak if you can do it without risk.
- Prevent entry into waterways, sewers, basements or confined areas.
- Use Spill Kits. Absorb or cover with dry earth, sand or other non-combustible material and transfer to containers.
- Use clean, non-sparking tools to collect absorbed material.

### **FIRE**

- Dry chemical, CO2, water spray or regular foam

### **FIRST AID**

- Call emergency or medical service.
- Ensure that medical personnel are aware of the material(s) involved and take precautions to protect themselves.
- Move victim to fresh air if it can be done safely.
- Give artificial respiration if victim is not breathing.
- Administer oxygen if breathing is difficult.
- Remove and isolate contaminated clothing and shoes.
- In case of contact with substance, immediately flush skin or eyes with running water for at least 20 minutes.
- Wash skin with soap and water.
- In case of burns, immediately cool affected skin for as long as possible with cold water.
- Do not remove clothing if adhering to skin.
- Keep victim calm and warm.
