3. Ensure all employees working on the conveyor to give clearance before starti
the conveyor system.
4. All personnel in the operations area should be alerted by a signal or by
designated person that the conveyor is about to start.
5. Do not start the conveyor system unnecessary when there is no requirement
6. Supervisors should ensure that anyone who works in a conveyor area mu
know the location and function of emergency stop/start controls.
7. Ensure that area around loading and unloading points must be kept clear
obstructions that could create a hazard.
8. Sticky materials such as tapes, stickers from shipments sticked on the convey
belt should be cleaned as often as required for safety of operation.

- 10. Before restarting a conveyor that has been stopped because of an emergency, an inspection of the conveyor should be conducted and the cause of the emergency stop determined.
- 11. Only authorized/trained personnel shall be permitted to operate/maintain a conveyor.
- 12. DON'T modify or misuse conveyor controls. Conveyor controls should never be modified by unqualified personnel. Any changes must be approved by management.
- 13. Report any vibrations, unwanted sounds, burning smell, omitting of too much heat near the motors of the conveyor to maintenance engineer immediately.
- 14. Report all unsafe conditions to your supervisor/manager. Such as, loose guards, people working too closely with the conveyors with unrestrained clothes or hair, etc.
- 15. Visitors should also be informed of safe behavior standards if they are going to be near conveyors.
